

## Annual Students Awards -2024 Saegis Campus

The Vice Chancellor's Award and the Dean's Award shall be awarded annually to two students with the overall performance (academic and extracurricular activities) in each Faculty under the approved marking scheme. These awards are funded by the University and administered by the office of the Deputy Vice Chancellor with the collaboration of faculties, and assistance of the Examination and the Student Affairs branches.

#### 1. The Vice Chancellor's Award and the Dean's Award

The best overall student and the second-best student, who completed the academic programme from each faculty shall be selected under the approved marking scheme for the Vice Chancellor's Award and for the Dean's Award, respectively.

1.1. A Medal and a Certificate of Achievement shall be awarded to the award recipients under the approved marking scheme at the General Convocation and students of the graduating batch will be eligible for the Award.

## 2. Application Procedure

- a) Students shall apply for the awards using the application forms issued by the University. Application forms will be available at Dean's office and can also be downloaded from the university website site.
- b) Students shall submit certified copies of all the documentary evidence with the application.
- c) Students shall submit their applications through the Registrar, who shall certify the contents of the applications, to the relevant Dean.
- d) Students shall prepare and participate in an interview if the selection panel requests.

#### 3. Eligibility Requirements

#### 3.1. Academic

#### Requirements

The students obtaining a higher GPA at least for a Second-Class Upper Division for local degrees or higher marks at least to receive a Merit pass for foreign programmes are eligible to apply for awards if the relevant examinations of the courses of study are completed in each relevant semester without sitting for repeat examinations.

### 3.2. Other Requirements

- a) Overall marks depend on academic achievements and contribution to extracurricular activities.
- b) The overall score achieved by the applicant shall be 70 marks or above for the Vice Chancellor's Award and 65 marks or above for the Dean's Award.
- c) Any student who has been punished by the University and/or warned (in writing) by the Vice Chancellor or Deputy Vice Chancellor as found guilty of any misconduct shall not be eligible for an award.

#### 4. Selection Criteria

## 4.1. Academic Achievements (Maximum 60 marks)

The applicant having the highest overall % marks at the end of the programme be given 60 marks and other applicants shall be given marks which are scaled down according to their marks.

## **4.2.** Sports achievements (Maximum 20 marks)

Maximum twenty marks shall be allocated for Sports achievements as follows.
